

Cockburn Island Township Landfill Policy

Adopted by the Township Council, July 10th, 2024

Accepted Waste

We encourage land owners to drop off all compostable materials in the designated blue bin located at the end of the road leading into the landfill.

Acceptable waste includes:

- General household garbage
- Compostable Materials
- Branches/trees (less than 5” dia)
- Cardboard
- Grass Clippings
- Paper Products
- Roofing shingles and drywall – Contact Public Works for specific instructions

Unacceptable Waste

To preserve our Island the following items are recommended to be removed from the Island by land owner.
